

NOTICE TO PATIENTS

State law, A.R.S. §32-1401 (25) (ff), requires that a physician notify a patient that the physician has a direct financial interest in a separate diagnostic or treatment agency to which the physician is referring the patient and/or in the non-routine goods or services being prescribed by the physician, and whether these are available elsewhere on a competitive basis.
